

Ipratropium Bromide (Atrovent ®)

Protocols:

1. Nebulized Bronchodilators


Indications:

1. Bronchial asthma
2. Bronchospasm in emphysema
3. Chronic bronchitis
4. Other wheezing in adults and pediatrics

Contraindications:

1. Hypersensitivity to ipratropium bromide
2. Hypersensitivity to atropine or its derivatives

Dosing:

1. Adult: 500 mcg/3 ml combined with Albuterol 2.5 mg/3ml, nebulized
2. Pediatric: For children aged 5 or under, Ipratropium 250 mcg should be given 

Expected Effects:

1. Decreased wheezing
2. Decreased respiratory distress

Side Effects:

1. Palpitations
2. Dry Mouth
3. Anxiety
